## Welcome to FOTW's Annual Sukkot of 2022

### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this letter is to give you proper expectations for the time you will be camping with us. This way you can properly prepare and plan for your trip.

### **Location:**

2040 Weber Way, Show Low, AZ 85901

### **Dates:**

Sukkot starts on October 10, 2022, and ends October 16, 2022, followed by Shemini Atzerets on October 17, 2022

\*Biblical calendar begins at sunset the day before\*

The campsite will be available for set up as early as Thursday, October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

**Cost:** \$50 per person staying on FOTW property

### **Weather:**

This year's weather prediction for the White Mountain Lakes during the week of Sukkot is showing  
68°/39°

This year will be a cooler sukkot experience and because of the cooler weather we recommend that you prepare accordingly.

The White Mountains area is known for their high winds, on a very windy day we can see gusts averaging up to 55 - 65 mph with sustained winds of 25 mph. We highly do recommend that your tents can hold strong winds and high gusts.

### **Camping expectations:**

Tent sites:

The campsite is a dry camping site. What does this mean? No Electricity! Dry camping simply means that you will not have water spickets and electricity at every site. However, we do have limited electricity on the property where you can charge your phones and laptops. There are water spickets at walking distance. You will have the opportunity to fill jugs for drinking water and personal use. You are welcome to bring inverted generators (only) to power up your electronics during the day at your camp sites.

RV and Campers sites:

We do have RV sites. We can accommodate a total of 3 RV/campers. Reservations will be held on a first come, first serve bases. Your RV reservation will not be counted until the application and fee

have been received and processed by the FOTW office. The sites are also dry camp sites, which means there are no hook-ups for dumping waste or grey water directly at the sites

Restroom facilities:

We have restroom facilities and showers. The restrooms are portable toilets that will be maintained regularly. There will be running water for washing your hands and showers facilities.

**Food:** FOTW will be offering breakfast for most mornings, at a cost this year during Sukkot. Breakfast will be offered Monday, October 10, 2022 – Friday, October 14, 2022. We will have a flat rate for the all of the days, and it will be collected prior to the event. All children, 4 and under will eat for free but they need to be registered if they are going to eat. Children 5-11 will eat for \$25, each child for the week and all individuals from ages 12 – Wise will eat for \$35, each person for the week.

FOTW will also provide one dinner, free of cost for those paying the \$50 Sukkot fee. If you are interested in joining us for dinner but are not staying on the property, each plate will be \$5 per person and per plate.

We implemented the “ushpizin” dinner last year and it was a great success. We will continue with that dinner idea this year. With that said, you will be responsible for providing lunch and dinner for your family and breakfast for three of the eight mornings. We recommend that you bring with you all equipment necessary for you to provide meals for your family. We will be having corporate potlucks during the High Holy service days; two lunch and 2 dinner potlucks to be precise.

What is an “ushpizin” dinner? In the spirit of Sukkot, we encourage that you invite one another to your campsites and have “ushpizin” enter your sukkah’s. Ushpizin is an Aramaic word meaning visitors. The concept of ushpizin, during Sukkot, is to share dinner with guests. By opening your home to guests, you are essentially dining with Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph, Moses, Aaron and David. In the Millennium kingdom we will be dining with these great men with our Messiah King, Yeshua. We rehearse that wonderful time that awaits the righteous.

We are only 11 miles from Snowflakes where Walmart and Bashas are located and 10 miles from Show Low (proper) where Safeway is located.

\*Equipment needed for cooking: camping stoves, propane for cooking, pots and pans, prep table, utensils, coolers are a few examples.
